Bihar: Campaign for sixth phase of LS polls to end today

Patna, May 23 (IANS) The campaign for the sixth phase of the Lok Sabha election will end on Thursday at 5 pm in Bihar.

The polling for the sixth phase will be held in eight Lok Sabha constituencies -- Siwan, Sheohar, Vaishali, Maharajganj, Purvi Champaran, Paschim Champaran, Gopalganj (SC Reserved) and Valmiki Nagar on May 25 -- where 86 candidates are in the fray; among them, 78 are male while eight are female candidates. In Siwan, JD-U has given the ticket to Vijayalakshmi Kushwaha, wife of former MLA Ramesh Kushwaha. The RJD has fielded former Assembly Speaker Awadh Bihari Chaudhary while the former MP Shahabuddin's wife Hena Shahab is contesting as an independent candidate. In Sheohar, RJD has given the ticket to Ritu aishwal while JDU has fielded Bahubali Anand Mohan's wife Lovely Anand. AIMIM has fielded Rana Ranjit Singh while Yogi Akhileshwar Das will contest as an independent. The main contest however is expected to be between JD-U and RJD candidates.

LS polls: PM Modi to hold election rallies in Haryana, Punjab; HM Shah in UP

New Delhi, May 23 (IANS) Prime Minister Narendra Modi will address public meetings in Haryana and Punjab on Thursday for the ongoing Lok Sabha election. In Haryana, Prime Minister Modi is scheduled to address a public meeting in Bhiwani-Mahendragarh at 2 p.m. Later at 4:30 p.m., he will address another public rally in Punjab's Patiala.

Major political developments that will unfold across the country on Thursday:

*Union Home Minister Amit Shah will address four public meetings in Uttar Pradesh on Thursday -- one in Siddharthnagar at 12:15 p.m., another in Sant Kabir Nagar at 1:30 p.m. followed by another public rally in Ambedkar Nagar at 3 p.m. Later, he will also address a public meeting in Pratapgarh at 4:15 p.m.

Solapur dam boat tragedy: Five bodies fished out, one missing

Solapur (Maharashtra), May 23 (IANS) The NDRF has found the bodies of five persons, comprising a family of four and a boatman who perished after a motorboat flipped over in a sudden storm hit Ujani Dam, an official said here on Thursday. According to Indapur Police Inspector Suryakant Kokane, the NDRF and police rescue teams have brought out the bodies of the Jadhav family and the boatman Anurag Avghade. "After a massive day-long search operation, we have recovered the bodies of five victims. A teenage boy Gaurav Dongre is still missing. We have launched a fresh effort to track him down," Kokane told IANS.

Met Dept sounds 'red alert' in parts of Raja.

Jaipur, May 23 (IANS) The Met Department has issued a 'red alert' in 22 districts of Rajasthan as the heatwave continues in the state. The 'red alert' has been issued in Alwar, Baran, Bharatpur, Bundi, Dausa, Dholpur, Jaipur, Jhunjhunu, Karauli, Kota, Sawai Madhopur, Sikar, Tonk, Ganganagar, Hanumangarh, Churu, Bikaner, Jodhpur, Jaisalmer, Nagaur, Pali and Barmer districts. The Met Department has also sounded 'orange alert' in Jalore, Jhalawar, Bhilwara and Ajmer districts. Barmer remained the hottest in Rajasthan recording a temperature of 48 degrees Celsius, which was the highest temperature recorded this season in the state. Phalodi registered a temperature of 47.8 degrees Celsius, Fatehpur 47.6, Churu recorded 47.4 degrees Celsius while Jalore-Jaisalmer recorded 47.2 degrees Celsius temperature. The maximum day temperature in Phalodi, Jodhpur, Barmer, Sikar, Pilani, Jaisalmer, and Churu was recorded at 5 degrees above normal.

- Stay indoors as much as possible
- Try home remedies like raw mango with coriander in onion salad which is highly effective against heatstroke."
- Do not burn dry leaves, agricultural waste, or other waste materials in your surroundings
- Try and maximise the use of energy-efficient equipment, clean fuels and alternative sources of energy

**Precautions for Farmers and Cattle-Breeders**

- Try irrigating the fields during the early morning or evening period
- Boost irrigation during critical stages of crop growth
- Maintain the soil moisture and prevent erosion through weeding
- Keep the cattle under the shade and beef up their clean and cool water intake.
- Avoid taking the cattle out between 11 AM and 4 PM
- Put curtains on the poultry house and ensure its proper ventilation
- Feed your cattle with green fodder, mineral-rich and fat-free fodder
- Install fans in the animal shelter if possible. Sprinkle water frequently and paint the animal shelter with dung, clay, or white coloured paint

Delhi HC issues guidelines for sale of refurbished hard disk drives

New Delhi, May 23 (IANS) The Delhi High Court has issued directions regarding the sale of used and refurbished Hard Disk Drives (HDDs) to ensure transparency and prevent consumer deception.

This ruling came in response to lawsuits filed by Seagate Technology LLC and Western Digital Technologies Inc against various entities selling refurbished HDDs under different brand names.

Justice Anish Dayal mandated that the packaging of refurbished HDDs must prominently display the name of the original manufacturer in a manner that avoids misleading

consumers into thinking they are purchasing a new product.

The court specified that references to the original manufacturers should use word marks like "Seagate" or "WD" and explicitly prohibited the use of original logos to prevent consumer confusion.

Additionally, the court directed that sellers must clearly state that these refurbished products do not come with any manufacturer's warranty or service.

This information must be included in promotional materials, websites, e-commerce listings, brochures, and manuals related to the refurbished HDDs.

The defendants in the case, including Daichi International, Consistent Infosystems Pvt Ltd, Geonix International Pvt Ltd, and Cubicor Information Systems Pvt Ltd, were accused of refurbishing end-of-life HDDs, repackaging them, and selling them under their brand names with extended warranties.

Bengal's Nandigram tense following murder of woman BJP worker

Kolkata, May 23 (IANS) Tension has prevailed at Nandigram in the East Midnapore district of West Bengal following the recovery of a hacked body of a woman BJP worker. A couple of other BJP supporters, who were also injured in the attack by unknown miscreants on early Thursday morning, have been admitted at a local hospital for treatment. The incident took place just 48 hours before the sixth phase of Lok Sabha polls, with Nandigram being one of the seven assembly constituencies under Tamuk Lok Sabha which is among the eight Parliamentary constituencies in the state that will go to polls on May 25.

Gurugram: Campaign for 6th phase of LS polls to end, 23 candidates in fray

Gurugram, May 23 (IANS) Campaign for the sixth phase of Lok Sabha elections will end on Thursday by 6.00 pm in Gurugram. Among the 10 parliamentary constituencies of Haryana going to the polls in the sixth phase, Gurugram has garnered a fair share of the limelight as it is among the biggest economic centres of the country. A total of 23 candidates are in the fray for the Gu-

gurugram Lok Sabha seat. Five candidates from major parties candidates include Rao Inderjit Singh, contesting on Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) ticket, Raj Babbar from Congress, Rahul Yadav a.k.a Fazilpuria from Jannayak Janata Party (JJP), Vijay Kumar from Bahujan Samaj Party (BSP), and Sorab Khan from the Indian National Lok Dal (INLD).
